

## **South Australia's Outcomes Framework for Children and Young People - Transcript**

### **Dr Anne Glover AO:**

'For the past 18 months, the Child Development Council has been talking to children, families, communities, government agencies, non-government agencies – we've been talking to hundreds of South Australians to determine what is important in children's lives.

What will help all of our children grow strong and healthy and lead active, productive lives?

What we've discovered are 20 important conditions. From these conditions, we have developed South Australia's first ever Outcomes Framework for Children and Young People.

The Outcomes Framework identifies 5 key outcomes that are necessary for all children and young people. These outcomes are that all South Australians, from birth to 18 years; are safe and nurtured; are physically, mentally and emotionally healthy; are successful learners; are happy, inspired and engaged; and are participating actively in society.

How fortunate we are that we have developed an Outcomes Framework that will allow us to monitor and track the development of all young South Australians.

It was a very special day on the 14 of November 2019 when the Outcomes Framework for Children and Young People was gazetted. We look forward to everyone coming on board, using it, to ensure that every young South Australian has the best possible life.'
