


First Review of

Every young South Australian counts







There are more than 369,000 children and young people under the age of 18 years living in South Australia - that's 21% of our total population (2020).

Children and young people come from diverse background and cultures with many different circumstances.

- 4.9% are Aboriginal
- 1.12% are in out-of-home care
- 16.7% live with disability



It's important for us to work together to enable children and young people to grow strong and to be happy, healthy and safe with opportunities for the future.

You can influence change by telling us what's important to you and your communities.

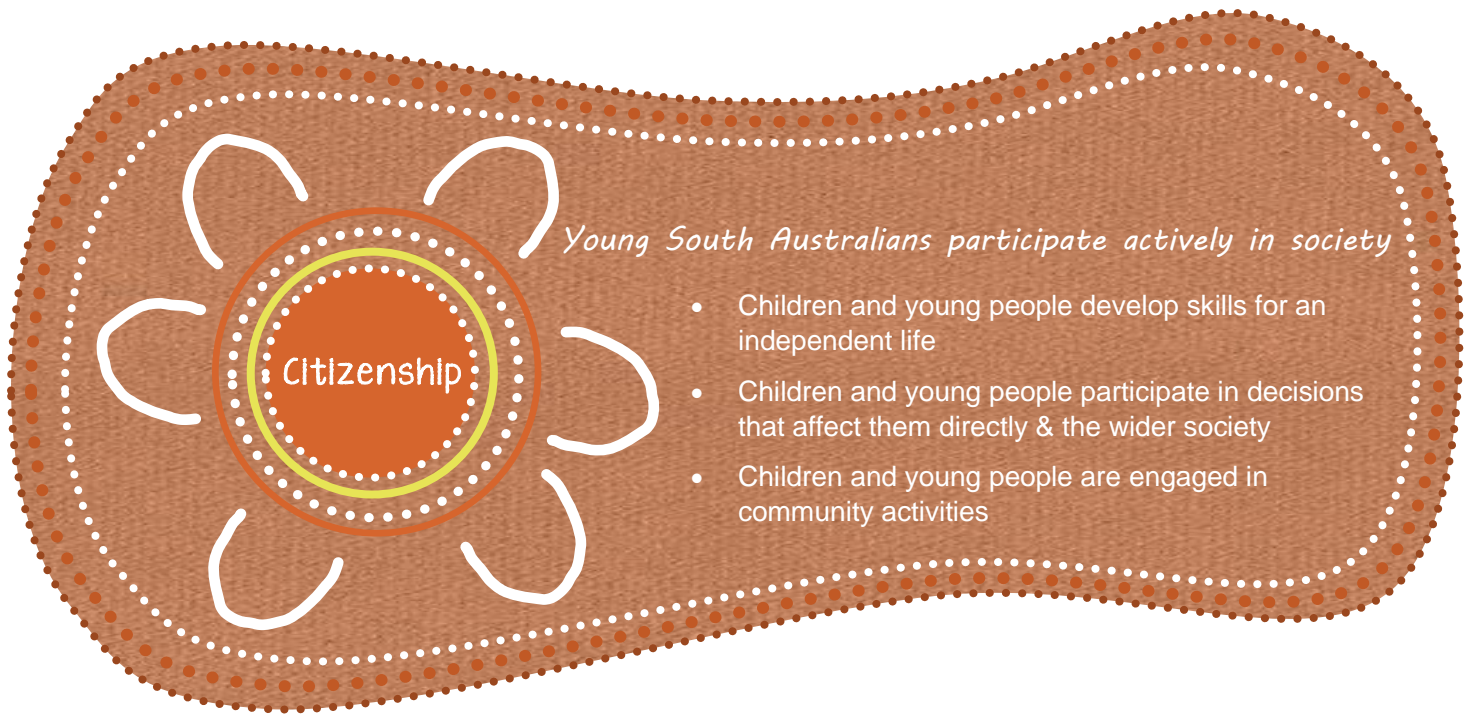
